



US GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL SOUTH FLORIDA CHAPTER STUDENT/EMERGING PROFESSIONALS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY

An applicant must be either a full-time university-/college-enrolled student in any discipline related to the building industry, or an emerging professional, defined as an individual under 30 years of age and working in any discipline related to the building industry. An applicant must be a member in good standing of the USGBC South Florida Chapter. Relatives or employees of any member of the Board of Directors of the Chapter or the Chapter's Donors Circle sponsors are not eligible. The US Green Building Council South Florida Chapter (the "Chapter") does not discriminate on the basis of any categorization.

DEADLINES

For the current round of applicants, June 30, 2011. For the timeframe for winners to claim their awards, December 31, 2011.

AMOUNT AND MANNER OF AWARD

The scholarship includes one LEED workshop registration fee; one LEED Reference Guide; one exam prep guide (from GBCI); and one enrollment to take the exam associated with either the LEED Green Associate or LEED AP with Specialization accreditation. Recipients will be registered by the Chapter at the then-applicable rate as specified by GBCI for the appropriate exam. The scholarship amount will not exceed \$1,000 per recipient. Student/ Emerging Professionals Scholarship Program grants are non-renewable. Recipients who fail to attend a class for which they have registered without an adequate excuse (e.g., death in the family, debilitating injury or illness) and who do not cancel their reservation in time to permit refund of the monies distributed forfeit their award and will be asked to reimburse the Chapter.
